### A Message from the Leadership Team: Ana Lombera, Senior Director of Program Management

I joined Dynanet in the Fall of 2018 to lead our NASA Headquarters contract focused on Enterprise Architecture alignment and IT portfolio automation support. Today, I continue to lead our NASA project with a new focus on Capital Planning and Investment Control (CPIC) and IT Portfolio Management. Additionally, I lead our Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Office of the Inspector General (OIG) contract focused on IT Portfolio Management and Enterprise Architecture. These two contracts have allowed Dynanet to expand our Enterprise Architecture Practice and deliver valuable outcomes to our customers who rely on our team's joint expertise to bridge business strategy with IT execution. One of the key areas the NASA and HHS teams are working on is guiding our customers towards IT modernization. At NASA, we have developed an end-to-end IT Investment Fund (ITIF) process that allows the agency to prioritize and select IT modernization investments and will enable the implementation of an IT Modernization Working Capital Fund (WCF). At HHS, we have created an Enterprise Architecture program to help guide business transformation and define the OIG's path towards modernizing their legacy system/application portfolio. I look forward to helping expand our Dynanet footprint within these agencies and our areas of support for 2021 and beyond. I thank every NASA and HHS team member for their hard work and dedication and welcome our new team members.

### Dynanet Project Highlights

In collaboration with two large IT contractors, Dynanet continues improving and modernizing GSA's IT infrastructure while aligning the application portfolio with the agency's business needs. Dynanet has retired and replaced aging applications built on mainframe and legacy infrastructure by infusing and merging the cloud and modern technologies' power, including microservices and application programming interfaces (APIs). Dynanet architected and implemented software development practices based on DevSecOps and Agile methodology leveraging techniques, including fully automated continuous integration and continuous deployment pipelines, achieving product and software development efficiencies, and increased visibility into the entire software development lifecycle.

### Dynanet Employee Spotlight



In 2010, Sree Mallampally joined Dynanet as a full stack senior Java lead developer to support the Office of Personnel Management's (OPM) Central Verification System (CVS) - a key system supporting security clearance reciprocity throughout the federal government. The project was to migrate the system running on Legacy IBM Mainframe ADABAS database and Natural programming language to JAVA Spring MVC Portlets. Sree rejoined the Dynanet team in 2019 joining the EPIC Support Contract. As the team leader for the Case Data Management group, Sree is responsible for the development, maintenance and support of a suite of Java applications used

in the government's background clearance investigation process. These mission critical systems operate 24x7x365 providing imaging and document management capabilities to process millions of eQIP applications throughout the adjudication process. Sree has been a major contributor to Dynanet's efforts to implement a CI/CD pipeline that will be used across the Dynanet EPIC contract. Her leadership skills and experience using Agile and related tools are a major factor in Dynanet's success supporting the EPIC contract.
