Dynanet Project Highlights

Dynanet was awarded a Prime Contract to support the Health and Human Services (HHS), Office of the Inspector General (OIG), Office of Technology (OIT) on April 1st, 2020. Our team is providing support services for Information Technology Portfolio Management and Enterprise Architecture. As part of our project, the Dynanet team is focused on establishing an Enterprise Architecture program that drives business transformations, defining IT governance practices for technology and IT program portfolio management, developing a Cloud strategy and IT strategy, assessing a portfolio of legacy applications & new IT products, and architecting new modernized applications. Additionally, our Technical Architect and AWS Cloud Solution Architect are conducting an assessment of the HHS OIG AWS environment. We are anticipating our team will double in size this year to provide additional support for legacy application analysis and technical strategy. This will allow us to help HHS OIG reduce technical complexity, increase flexibility and scalability, and optimize costs as they continue to modernize their technology portfolio in support of the HHS OIG mission and programs.

Upcoming

In May, Dynanet submitted a Prime bid for NASA Glenn Research Center (GRC) Professional, Administrative, Computational, and Engineering (PACE V) Services. This opportunity is valued at over \$150M and is slated to be in operation from 2021–2026. The contract will include IT support and sustainment ranging from data management, business intelligence and analytics to cybersecurity. To date this is one of the largest Prime Contract opportunities Dynanet has gone after. We feel Dynanet is very well positioned to win this work because of the great support our NASA team is currently providing and has provided to NASA over the past two years under the guidance and leadership of Ana Lombera.

With this win, Dynanet's NASA support footprint will include NASA HQ in DC, GRC in Cleveland, OH, and Kennedy Space Center in Cape Canaveral, FL. Please stay tuned as we await news about the award which should be announced by the end of the year.
