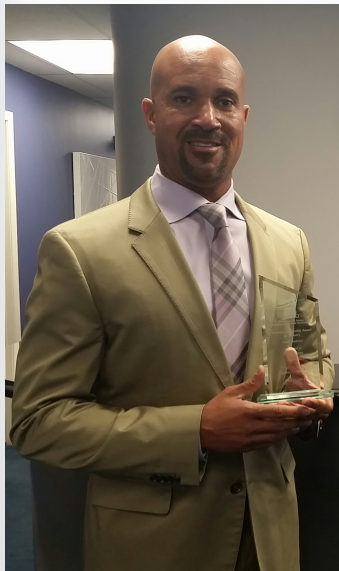

Dynanet Wins OPM Contract May 2019

Dynanet was awarded a Prime contract by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) to support Application Integration and Customization, Application Maintenance and Enhancements, and Application Administration Support. Dynanet will support OPM's National Background Investigations Bureau (NBIB) Information Technology Program Management Office (ITPMO), Electronic Privacy Information Center (EPIC) Support Branch, Operations and Enhancement Support Services to support the agency's Application Systems Development. OPM's NBIB ITPMO provides background investigation products and services to NBIB customer agencies. These products and services are then utilized as a basis for making security clearance, suitability, or fitness determinations as required by Executive Orders, other rules and regulations.

NASA Launch (IT Not Moon)

May 2019

In late 2018, Dynanet was awarded a Prime contract by the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) to support the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO). Dynanet is developing strategies and policies to enable the alignment of the NASA OCIO IT Portfolio vision with the mission needs of the 10 NASA Centers. Dynanet is reviewing manual processes and applying Robotics Process Automation (RPA) solutions to automate them.

The initial success of our Enterprise Architecture and RPA work led to Dynanet's current work with NASA's Marshall Space Center in Huntsville, AL. Our team of six employees implemented Clarity Project Portfolio Manager (PPM) in less than four months, which successfully went live on April 22, 2019. Clarity PPM platform helps agencies effectively and efficiently manage their products, services, peoples, and finances. The platform facilitates and improves the delivery of project and programs. In May, Sean Peay, Peter Anih, and Michael Gaffney travelled to Alabama to congratulate the Clarity PPM team on a job well done.

Agile Coaching at NASA
